# GUYANA ELECTIONS COMMISSION NOTICE

### **Entry into Force of Registers of Voters**

(Local Government Elections 2023)

Section 23(4) of the Local Authorities (Elections) Act, Cap. 28:03, provides that the Register of Voters for each Local Authority Area shall come into force at such time as shall be prescribed by the Elections Commission by notice published in the *Gazette* and shall be open for inspection at all reasonable times at the offices of the local authority.

The Elections Commission has extracted the registers of voters for each local authority area for which elections will be held at the Local Government Elections scheduled for 12 June 2023, and the Elections Commission hereby gives notice that the said registers of voters shall come into force and be open for inspection at the respective offices of the local authorities on 28 March 2023.

Pursuant to Sections 24 and 24A of the Local Authorities (Elections) Act, any omission or incorrect inclusion in the registers may be brought to the attention of the Commission by reporting this to any registration office of the Elections Commission and presenting any evidence available to satisfy the Commission of the requirement for any insertion or correction to be made.
